

ROKOKAURI RD URBAN UPGRADE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Why are you doing this work?

We are urbanising and upgrading this section of road to improve safety for our residents.

2. What does urbanising the road mean?

Urbanising the road involves taking the road from looking rural to one with footpaths, kerb and channel.

3. Why are you only upgrading half the road?

Staff worked closely with one of the key developers in the area to tie-in this upgrade project with other development happening in the area. It also means doing the upgrade now will reduce the amount of temporary works needed in the future and brings forward a key project which was previously not planned to be delivered this year.

4. When will the other half of the road be upgraded?

This is a work in progress, and timing will be determined by our Rotokauri Arterial Designation (looking at where our roads should go in the area) project.

5. How long will the road closure be in place?

Approximately five days.

6. How long will you be working on Rotokauri Rd for?

Approximately 15 weeks.

7. What is the detour route for traffic?

Baverstock Rd, Brymer Rd and on to Rotokauri Rd and vice versa.

8. What's the alternative route for people on bikes/pedestrians?

There will be a temporary shared path for users situated along Rotokauri Rd.

9. Will there be any disruption to bus users?

Bus users will need to use the bus stop on the corner of Baverstock Rd and Rotokauri Rd. For more information visit busit.co.nz.

10. Will I still be able to access my house?

Yes, access to all houses/businesses will be maintained.

11. Can I still access the Zoo and Waiwhakareke Natural Heritage Park?

Yes, this work does not affect these two facilities.
