Further to your information request of 7 December 2014, in respect of matters affecting [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Hamilton (as attached), I am now able to provide Hamilton City Council's response.

You requested:

1.1 *"From what sources do the electronic, on line, plans originate?"*

The contractor or designer. In this case it was Council, who was the designer. The final design drawing was used as the a built drawing.

1.2 *"Who was responsible for producing the original plans on which the online plans are based with regard to delineating the position of the HCC pipes?"*

The original plans were produced by Council's City Engineers Office in 1968.

1.3 *"What procedure was followed to ensure the accuracy of the original plans [we note the generic warning on the plans]?"*

The procedure used in 1968 is unknown.

1.4 *"Are the online plans an accurate copy of the original plans [as amended] following the addition of the location of the pipes?"*

Yes, the online copy is an accurate representation of the original plans.

1.5 *"Who uploaded the online version of the plans?"*

The plans were originally transferred by hand to our asset maps which illustrate the city's networks . It was these city maps that were digitised by Transfield in 2005.

2. *"Please confirm if the original plans are available for viewing, and if so when would be a suitable time to view those plans?"*

Please contact Mark Dearlove on 07 8386699 to arrange a suitable time to view the plans.

The original plans were microfiched (date unknown), and then the microfiche copy was digitised several years ago. We have not searched our archives for the original plan. The electronic copy of the original plans was sent to you previously.
