Kia ora,

Further to your information request of 12 May 2019 in respect of poultry feed, I am now able to provide Hamilton City Council's response.

You requested:

What is the total weight of poultry feed purchased for the poultry at Taitua Arboretum by Hamilton City Council from 1 June 2005 to April 18, 2019.

Our response:

Poultry food is purchased under a blanket purchase order with one of our suppliers and as such is not itemised on that Purchase order.

Staff at Taitua Arboretum started regularly feeding the Poultry at Taitua with kibble maize and chicken feed in 2008, particularly over winter when visitor numbers drop. Over the period 1 June 2005 to April 18, 2019 visitor numbers have almost doubled and visitors feeding the Poultry have been at a level where we have not had to supply feed on a daily basis to avoid over feeding. There is chicken food on hand if required.

A recent veterinary check confirms that the Poultry are in good health and their wellbeing is not compromised in any way, this was attached to our earlier response to titled LGOIMA 190100 - Taitua concerns.
