Further to your information request of 12 July 2019, in respect of Shaw's Bird Park, I am now able to provide Hamilton City Council's response.

You requested:

In the last couple of years there have been small silver tags with numbers on them placed on trees around the park. The Shaw's also gave access to someone who visited the park and took samples from the ponds with in relation to the fish that may be present. There was also access granted for someone that was investigating the presence of lizards here.

Can you please advise if this was a council action or at the request of council to third parties?. What dates these occurred and the reasons for these visits. Please provide a copy of any studies or findings from these visits.

Our response:

Council is not aware of any visits made by Council (or at the request of Council) to Shaw's Bird Park to take samples, investigate lizards, or place tags on trees.

Accordingly, your request is refused under s 17(g) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 on the basis that the information requested is not held by Hamilton City Council and we do not have grounds for believing that the information is held by another organisation, or more closely connected with the functions of another organisation.

If you have any concerns with the decision(s) referred to in this response, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.
