Further to your information request of 2 August 2019 in respect of E-scooter collection costs, I am now able to provide Hamilton City Council's response.

### You requested:

*With respect, I request the following information under the terms of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 any memos, reports or briefing notes, including drafts, prepared by officials since 1 October 2018 until 31 July 2019 relating to the costs of retrieving hire e-scooters from water locations (e.g harbours, rivers, streams).*

*The information sought in this request is to be used as part of a report by NZME into the costs of retrieving e-scooters from where they shouldn't be.*

*As the information will be used to inform listeners and readers of the said costs, I ask that any fee is waived.*

### Our response

We have not licensed any e-scooter providers at this time so we have not discussed any fees or charges for HCC to remove and on-charge to e-scooter hire companies. We also do not have any memos, reports, briefing notes, or drafts relating to the costs of retrieving hire e-scooters from water locations.

Hamilton City Council has discussed a code of practice for operators of personal use transport vehicles, the proposed permitting process, fees and charges and Code of Practice for a new activity under the Public Places Bylaw (provision and use of Personal Hire Devices (PHDs) in public places).
