Kia ora Mayor Andrew

The following provides a high level overview of the support that Hamilton City Council provided to the arts community within Hamilton City this year including grants and services.

Included in the following table is a list of grants and funding support provided to the arts by Hamilton City Council. Due to the increase in the funding available for allocation in 2018/19 year, the level of funding for individual organisations has generally increased this year from previous years. The Multi-Year grant has not previously included Riverlea or Clarence Street, but it did include Orchestra Central, Operatic, Society of Arts and Civic Choir. Council also did not previously have the Community Event Fund therefore some events would have been funded through the single-year grant.

In relation to Council services, Hamilton City Council operates the Waikato Museum. The current annual budgets for the Museum are as follows;

Opex - \$5,700,000 – Includes direct and indirect costs

Capex - \$925,000- Includes collections and facilities renewals

A portion of the operations budget is used to enable (\$30,000) and maintain (\$25,000) Public Art. There are currently 29 pieces in the Public Art register.

Council also supports the arts through the provision of a Policy And Strategy Advisor for Arts and Community. This role sits within the Community Group and a portion of this staff members time is dedicated to supporting arts outcomes.
