Further to your information request in relation to the capacity of the water network, I am now able to provide Hamilton City Council's response.

You requested:

How many additional households could be connected to the water network before exceeding the capacity of fresh/wastewater resources?

Our response:

The water network consists of a Water Treatment Station, a network of storage reservoirs and pumps as well as a reticulated network. There are significant planned investments over time to make sure that the network can meet the forecast demand, which is subject to many assumptions. The question asked is complicated to answer but at present we estimate that the existing Water Treatment Plant could accommodate an additional 5,000 households before capacity is exceeded.
