Kia ora,

Further to your information request on 21 April 2020 in respect to tyre recycling in New Zealand, I am now able to provide Hamilton City Council's response.

You requested:

More specifically, you have requested the following information for one year, 2019 - 2020:

- 1. Quantities of motor vehicle tyres to landfill within your jurisdiction;*
- 2. The name of the landfill that is used for redundant tyres generated within your jurisdiction; and*
- 3. The quantities of any known motor vehicle tyres storage/tyre mountain/s within your jurisdiction.*

Our response:

1. Quantities of motor vehicle tyres to landfill within your jurisdiction for one year, 2019 - 2020?

Hamilton City Council's municipal Refuse Transfer Station at Lincoln St is leased to Waste Management NZ Limited. The Lincoln St facility does not accept tyres. Any tyres that have been disposed of illegally and can be identified in consolidated waste are separated and sent to the Waste Management tyre shredding facility in Wiri. However, there are no figures kept by Hamilton City Council relating to this information.

2. The name of the landfill that is used for redundant tyres generated within your jurisdiction.

Hamilton City Council do not send tyres to landfill from the Lincoln St Refuse Transfer station.

3. The quantities of any known motor vehicle tyres storage/tyre mountain/s within your jurisdiction.

Hamilton City Council is not aware of any motor vehicle tyres storage/tyre mountain/s within the Council's municipal boundaries.
