You requested:

I want to know the cost to the council for building the Parkour Park at Innes Common. I also want to know how much the Kompan section of the park cost.

Our response:

The Kompan fitness equipment cost \$180,000. This was supplied by Playground People. The safety surface underneath the fitness equipment cost \$70,000 and was supplied by Playtop.

The total cost of the parkour area was \$80,000. This was a custom build, designed by Parkour NZ.

Hannah Helleur (Project Manager) is more than happy to discuss the design process and equipment with Jared if he has any further queries.
