

Public notice - Alcohol licence

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Frankton Railway Bowling Club Incorporated has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the renewal and variation of the club licence in respect of the premises situated at 51A Rifle Range Road Dinsdale Hamilton - 3204 known as Frankton Railway Bowling Club. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a Sporting Club. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is sold under the licence are:

Sunday – Thursday: 8:00 A.M. to 10:30 P.M.

Friday and Saturday: 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 midnight

The applicant seeks the following variation to the licence conditions:

1. A Manager be on duty when more than 20 patrons present
2. Alcohol can be sold and supplied to guest of club members with which the licensee has an arrangements for.

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Hamilton District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council Municipal Building, Garden Place, Hamilton.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 15 working days after the date of the publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council, Private Bag 3010, Hamilton 3240.

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
