

# Public notice - Alcohol licence

## **Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012**

Amy's Flowers Ltd has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the renewal of the off-licence in respect of the premises situated at 24 Lincoln Street Frankton 3204, known as Amy's Flowers Ltd. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a Flower and Gift Basket Retailer. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is sold under the licence are:

From the shop – Alcohol may be sold on Monday to Sunday from 8.00am to 6.00pm, and no alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.

Remote sales and delivery – Gift baskets /hampers containing alcohol may be sold at any time of the day, and must not be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day, or between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day.

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Hamilton District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council Municipal Building, Garden Place, Hamilton.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may, not later than 15 working days after the date of the publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council, Private Bag 3010, Hamilton 3240.

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
