We are seeking expressions or interest from people interested in joining this effective decision-making team. The successful applicant will be formally approved by the Council.

- You must have experience relevant to alcohol licensing
- You can't be involved in the alcohol industry or have any appearance or bias
- You must have highly developed investigative skills and decision-making ability
- You must have strong communication skills
- You should have knowledge of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act and alcohol related harm.
