

Public notice - Alcohol licence

Section 101, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Jag and Gur Limited has made an application to the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council for the renewal and variation of an ON licence in respect of the premises situated at 22 Durham Street, Hamilton known as Yardhouse. The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is that of a Tavern. The applicant seeks to extend their current trading hours:

Current hours: Monday to Wednesday, from 10.00am to 10.00pm
Thursday, from 10.00am to 12midnight
Friday and Saturday, 10.00am to 1.00am the following day
Sunday, from 10.00 to 10.00pm

Proposed: Sunday to Wednesday, from 9.00am to 11.00pm
Thursday to Saturday, 9.00am to 1.00am the following day

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Hamilton District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council Municipal Building, Garden Place, Hamilton. To request an electronic copy of the application please email Licensing@hcc.govt.nz. Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the issue of the licence may file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at Hamilton City Council, Private Bag 3010, Hamilton 3240 or in email to Licensing@hcc.govt.nz. The objection must not be later than 2 working days after the date of the publication of this notice. The notice was originally notified 6th March 2020 but due to level 4 lockdown measures, the full 15 day objection period could not be observed. Hence there are 2 remaining days for any person to object.

No objection to the variation or cancellation of conditions of licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 105 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
