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- 1.0 The purpose of this supplementary statement is to reaffirm my position on the evidence from Ben Inger on behalf of Weston Lea, which was stated verbally within the hearing but was not included within my written right of reply.
- 2.0 Mr Inger recommended amended wording to Rule 25.8.3.10b relating to the construction of buildings to be used for noise sensitive activities near designated transport corridors. As I stated verbally within the hearing, I recommend that the alternative wording recommended by Mr Inger be accepted as it would improve the clarity of the rule.
