Andrew Watts		<p>Clarify that subdivision design standards do not apply to cross lease conversions, and require boundaries to be based on exclusive pattern of occupation where the underlying cross lease plan does not identify exclusive use areas (Rule 23.6.4):I support this provision as it will enable the rule to be used as a permitted activity (with no resource consent) as the district plan had intended.The design standards should not apply to a cross lease conversion, as the land has already been developed and is being used and the use is not intended to change. The requirement of boundaries to follow the pattern of occupation makes sense, as not all cross lease exclusive area are mathematically defined and could be defined by a wall, kerb or fence for example.I wish for this provision to be granted.</p>	Not Answered
