

Amended summary of decisions requested – Ruakura Variation

On 17 February 2016 Hamilton City Council publicly notified the availability of a summary of decisions requested and a further submission period to Variation 1 to the Proposed District Plan.

The summary has since been updated to add two submission points from the original submission period. Further submissions can now be made in support of, or in opposition to any **submissions in this additional summary. Further submissions close at 4.30pm, Wednesday 20 April 2016.**

The additional summary, and copies of the relevant submissions, are available at the Council's office in Garden Place, any Hamilton City Library or online at hamilton.govt.nz/ruakura

A further submission can only be made in support of, or in opposition to, another submission. It provides an opportunity for you to assess how an original submission may affect you, and to have your views considered by Council. The Resource Management Act 1991 states that only the following persons may make a further submission:

- any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest; and
- any person that has an interest in the proposed plan greater than the interest the general public has; and
- the local authority itself.

Further submissions can be made online or hard-copy forms are available from the locations listed above and can be emailed to districtplan@hcc.govt.nz, or sent to: City Planning Unit, Hamilton City Council, Private Bag 3010.

A copy of your further submission must be sent to the person who made the original submission within five working days after lodging the further submission with Council (addresses are available on the original submissions which can be viewed online or on request).
