



**RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991 - MINUTE #7 [AMENDED] -  
HEARINGS COMMISSIONERS**

---

1. Under section 34A of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA), Hamilton City Council has delegated to David Hill (Chair). Alan Watson and Shane Solomon, independent hearings commissioners, the hearing and decision on proposed Private Plan Change 2 – Te Awa Lakes (PC2).
2. PC2 was lodged on 11 September 2017, publicly notified on 1 November 2017, submissions closed on 29 November 2017 and further submissions closed on 2 February 2018.
3. By Minute #6 dated 30 June 2019, Commissioners set out an indicative timeline for the resumed hearing process. On 31 July 2019 we received correspondence from Perry Group's counsel, Derek Nolan QC, requesting some amendments to those dates as follows:
  - (a) Amending the date by which the material identified in items 1 to 10 in Minute #6 is to be supplied to on or before Wednesday 21 August 2019, to enable the Council to circulate it on or before Monday 26 August 2019;
  - (b) Amending the date for identifying or re-confirming any experts and their areas of expertise from 4pm Wednesday 14 August to 4pm Friday 30 August 2019; and
  - (c) Amending the starting date for expert caucusing from Monday 2 September to Monday 9 September 2019 with the same end date of 9 October 2019.
4. All other dates remain as indicated in Minute #6.
5. Commissioners have considered that request, understand that Council is agreeable to them, sees no prejudice to other parties, and therefore concludes that there is no good reason not to adopt them. Accordingly those amended dates are agreed.
