Issuing of voting documents

Voting documents will be posted to electors from Friday, 20 September 2019.

Return of voting documents

Voting documents must be returned not later than noon, Saturday, 12 October 2019 to the electoral officer.

Voting documents can be returned by post or hand delivered at the following council offices and libraries between Friday, 20 September 2019 and Friday, 11 October 2019 during normal office hours, and Saturday, 12 October 2019 between 9am – noon:

- the Elections Office, Municipal Building, Garden Place, Hamilton;
- Central, Chartwell, Dinsdale, Glenview, Hillcrest and St Andrews libraries;
- the Anglesea Street Council entrance drive (drop off voting) on election day only.

Special voting

Special voting in terms of the Local Electoral Act 2001 and the Local Electoral Regulations 2001 may be exercised at the above council offices and times.

A person can apply to enrol as either a residential or ratepayer elector right up to and including 11 October 2019 – the day before the close of voting.
