

Exclusive Rights of Burial:

Burial rights are deemed to be owned by the person named on our records.

The purchaser of an exclusive right of burial in any plot may transfer that right to a close relative subject to the approval of the Council and to payment of the prescribed fee.

The Council may at its discretion purchase back any unused plot on such terms and conditions as it sees fit.

If no burial has taken place after 60 years from the date of original sale, the exclusive right of burial in the plot lapses.

ASH INTERMENT PLOTS



The Memorial Walk is the main focus of the Garden of Memories. Its formal theme features a walkway through pergolas to a central fountain feature, which also caters for interments in its garden surround.

Provision for plaque only memorialisation on concrete kerbing is available in the Sunken Garden area of the Garden of Memories.

PLOT MANAGEMENT

Stages of Plot Management:

Cemetery Staff:

Freshly opened
Reinstating to garden
Ongoing care and management

Plot Owners:

Fresh flowers may be placed on the plot at the time of ash interment.

From time to time space may allow family to donate a small plant or shrub (other than roses) to be planted in the garden. Please ask the cemetery management if this option is available at the time. Fresh flowers may be placed in the containers provided by the cemetery, which are located in purpose built dispensers in the Garden of Memories.

Memorabilia or Tributes not permitted:

No artificial flowers or ornaments can be placed in the garden(s) or extended area around the memorial as they can be hazardous or make it difficult for us to maintain your plot. In these circumstances memorabilia will be removed by management.

Items not permitted will be removed and held for 1 month (in accordance with the Hamilton City Cemeteries and Crematorium Bylaw) and arrangement for collection can be made at the cemetery office between the hours of 8:30am to 4:00pm.

SPECIFICATIONS

Plots: All plots, except those in areas set aside for plaque memorialisation only, provide for the interment of up to two (2) sets of ashes, allowing one (1) plaque to be placed on the concrete kerb or the fountain surround.

Maximum urn size: 330mm x 205mm x 180mm

Plot Service:

Ashes are interred in the garden directly behind the kerb of the chosen plot, with the urn in an upright position, 300mm below the surface.

Ash Interments are to be booked either directly with the Cemetery administration office, which is open Monday to Friday 8.30am to 4.30pm, or a Funeral Director. Should family not wish to be present for the interment of the ashes, they can instruct cemetery staff to inter the ashes in their absence.

Temporary Plot Markers

No temporary plot markers are permitted in this area.

Memorial Purchase:

Memorial purchase is the responsibility of the family.

Bronze and Granite plaque purchases are to be made direct from any Monumental Mason approved by Hamilton Park Cemetery. **Porcelain** plaque purchase can be made direct from the manufacturer's Hamilton-based agents.

Memorials must meet NZS 4242 Headstone and Cemetery Monuments Standard and Cemetery and Crematorium Bylaw.

A permit form and plan must be submitted prior to construction and installation of memorial. Forms are available from the Cemetery Administration office, the cemetery website, or from a contracted Monumental Mason.

Granite plaques are to be installed by a qualified mason who is familiar with Hamilton Park Cemetery Health and Safety specifications.

Bronze and Porcelain plaques are delivered to the cemetery for staff to install.

Plaque Size & materials:

Please note as in our terms and conditions of purchase, no memorial will be installed where there are any outstanding debts.

One memorial is allocated to each plot. All plaques are to be made without locating lugs.

Emblems, borders or individual designs can be inscribed on the memorial.
