Further to our recent meeting with you at Temple View in September 2019 to discuss the progress with the Temple View project and the proposed removal of the Block Plant.


As Chairman of the New Zealand Labour Missionary Charitable Trust (the Trust), I speak for those who not only built the Block Plant but also operated it for many years. Our Labour Missionary members were involved with the production of the blocks and then used those blocks to construct all of the buildings on the former Church College site along with the Temple and a number of chapels throughout New Zealand and the Pacific Islands.

The Trust supports the Temple View Project and the goal to develop the land for residential housing. This is putting into practice the Church's desire to enhance the environment of Temple View for the benefit of the Temple precinct along with wider Temple View and Hamilton community. The provision of residential houses will benefit future generations and provide much needed housing for the wider community.

The Trust fully supports the proposal to remove the Block Plant. It was constructed as a very utilitarian building with its only purpose being to house the block making machine and block making materials. Once the need for the blocks ceased, the need for the building also ceased and ever since then it has been used for other school related functions.

The Block Plant has well outlived its purpose and it has no place in the Temple View Project. The Trust supports the proposal to demolish the Block Plant and use the land for much needed housing.
